



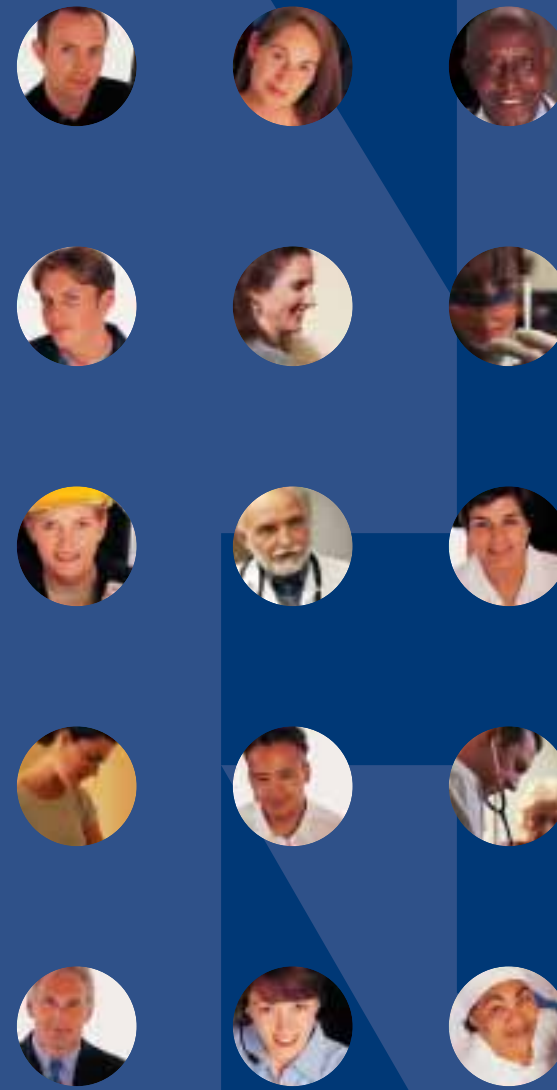

DIRECTIONS TO OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH SERVICES OF NORWALK HOSPITAL

Via Connecticut Turnpike - I-95 Northbound

Take Exit 15 (Route 7 Connector to Exit 1). Take Right onto Belden Avenue. Belden Avenue turns into 520 West Avenue. 520 West Avenue will be on the right hand side*.

Via Connecticut Turnpike - I-95 Southbound

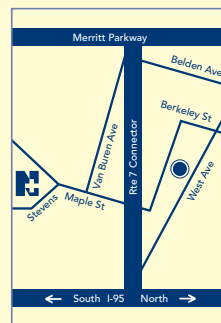
Take Exit 15. Bear right onto first off ramp. Take right onto West Avenue. 520 West Avenue is one block down on the left hand side*.

Via Merritt Parkway Northbound

Exit 39A (Route 7 Connector) to Exit 1. Take left onto Van Buren Avenue. Continue Straight for approximately two blocks. Take left onto Maple Street, and go under highway. Take first left onto Berkeley Street and a right into parking lot for 520 West Avenue.

Via Merritt Parkway Southbound

Take Exit 38 (Route 123). Turn right at exit and proceed straight on New Canaan Avenue - Route 123. Take left onto Maple Street, and go under highway. Take first left onto Berkeley Street and a right into the parking lot for 520 West Avenue.



*FREE parking from West Avenue take Maple Street to Berkeley Street, and take right into parking lot for 520 West Avenue.

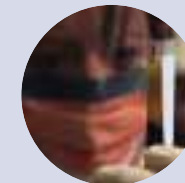

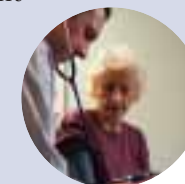

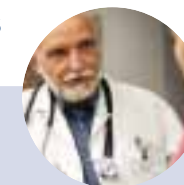
